Club & High School Participation - Meet Information

- 1) Club/High School gymnasts are NOT allowed to opt out of meets **outside** of HS season as they will be missing club meets during HS Season. High School gymnasts would be required to attend Gymnastics on the Grand, Follow Your Dreams and Qualifying Meets (States/Regionals/Nationals) should you gualify.
- 2) Per OHSAA, the cut off date to enter HS season is Jan. 12, 2026. This is the last date that club competition is allowed before competing for your high school team. IF you choose to enter your high school season after the cutoff date, you are allowed to sign up for Next Level Podium Challenge as well. You would be allowed to attend high school practices and competitions, but not able to compete for your high school until after your last club meet and would return to club meets AFTER your last HS meet (OHSAA states is March 7-8, 2026). Some athletes choose this option to give themselves more opportunities to ensure they have a state qualifying score, while some athletes choose to compete their full high school season. We support either decision.
- 3) Please note: HS Gymnasts must meet USAG score requirements in order to be eligible for States. It is ideal to achieve this score prior to the start of HS season.
